Community safety events – free bike registering

Our community safety team is hosting community events across the district over the next few months.

We'll be joined by our local policing colleagues at the sessions, where you'll have the chance to find out how we're working together to target crime and antisocial behaviour across the district.

You can also bring along your bike to any of the sessions, which can be marked for free and added to the National Bike Register Database.

The sessions are taking place on:

- Wednesday 1 July (9am to 12pm), Totton precinct
- Wednesday 8 July (9am to 12pm), Lymington, St Thomas Street car park

Food, recycling, and rubbish collections

 These items can go straight in the green-lidded recycling bin:

- plastic bottles (including spray bottles) keeping lids on; empty aerosols cans; paper but **not** tissues, kitchen roll or shredded paper; flattened cardboard

but **no** greasy takeaway boxes; empty tins and cans

No plastic bags, sacks, or liners should be used or put in the recycling bin, rather items should be added to the bin in a clean, dry and loose state

For general waste and food waste bins left outside, especially in the warmer weather of the summer months, the following steps can be taken to reduce the risk of pests gathering around the bins:

- clean your bins and caddies regularly; white vinegar can help remove smells
- use liners in both indoor and outdoor food waste bins
- make sure the waste food bin lid is locked
- put all food waste in your food waste caddy rather than your general rubbish bin as the former is collected weekly
- store bins out of direct sunlight where possible
