April 22 Earth Day 2024

Earth Day commemorates the importance of environmental conservation and sustainability, encouraging folk around the world to take action for a healthier planet and brighter future.

Here are some actions that we all might take to help achieve this:

Pick up litter: There are roughly 41 pieces of litter for each kilometre of footpath across the UK. Whether picking up litter as part of an organised litter pick or spending an hour tidying your local area, this is a great way to care for the planet.

Donate or sell unwanted items: Clear out those unused items by donating them to charity or second hand shops, or try to sell them yourself. It is far kinder to the planet to increase the lifespan of existing items than to buy brand new.

Make space for wildlife: If you have a garden, have a go at creating a designated space to go a bit wild; scatter wildflower seeds and don't mow the area. Wild areas are great for biodiversity and can attract pollinators like bees and butterflies.
