GOD IN LOVE Vote on registering our buildings for same sex marriages

You may remember that a vote was due to be taken at our July Church Council Meeting on whether or not to register our buildings for same sex marriages. However, that meeting was cancelled due to Rev'd Trish Davis suffering from Covid, and so the vote will be taken at our next Council meeting on Tuesday 19th October.

You may also remember the open meeting we had at the end of March where difficult issues explored, and deep and personal sentiments were shared. Only Council Members are permitted to vote, but all those who are not on Church Council are very warmly invited to make their feelings and feedback known to a member of Council, or to Trish so that they can be shared at the October Council Meeting. Any decision that is made then can be revisited in 5 years' time, but in the meantime, all are asked to be prayerful about the vote so we can seek the best way forward for the Church at this time.
